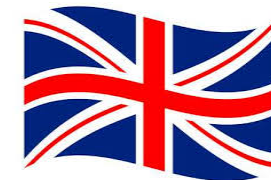




**RULES & ENTRY FORM FOR THE 2020**  
**"ALL BRITAIN DAIRY SHORTHORN AWARDS"**  
**PHOTOGRAPHIC COMPETITION**



1. Exhibitors will receive £20.00 per entry up to a maximum of 6 photos. There will not be a £20 entry payment for Class 10 Scenic Photo.  
*(Please submit an invoice to The Society for the photos entered in classes 1 to 7 – maximum of 6 can be charged for)*
2. All animals must be registered in the Coates's Herd Book Main or Supplementary Grading Register Grade B. To be red, white or roan in colour.
3. All photographs unless stated must have been taken between October 20<sup>th</sup> 2019 and October 20<sup>th</sup> 2020 inclusive.
4. Photographs must be of a professional quality *(not including Class 10)*
5. Animals to be presented to a professional standard with a standard side shot.
6. Entries will only be accepted from paid up members of the Shorthorn Society.
7. Entries must be in the Shorthorn Office before midnight on **Friday 30<sup>th</sup> October 2020** - **no late entries will be accepted.**
8. Entries can be either by email, saved to disc as jpegs, memory stick or hard copies 7 x 6 printed on photographic glossy paper  
**ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT A COMPLETED SIGNED ENTRY FORM**
9. Please mark all Photographs on the reverse with:  
**Exhibitors Name - Animals Name - Class - No of calves**
10. For scenic photos please state:  
**Exhibitors Name - Correlating number as on entry form**
11. In the event of a limited number of entries in any of the classes the Society reserves the right to amalgamate classes.

## **Classes**

- 1.) CALF BORN on or after 1<sup>ST</sup> March 2020
- 2.) CALF BORN between 1<sup>st</sup> Dec 2019 & 29<sup>th</sup> Feb 2020
- 3.) CALF BORN between 1<sup>st</sup> Sept & 30<sup>th</sup> Nov 2019
- 4.) CALF BORN between 1<sup>st</sup> May & 31<sup>st</sup> Aug 2019
- 5.) CALF BORN between 1<sup>st</sup> Jan & 30<sup>th</sup> April 2019
- 6.) HEIFER IN MILK TO FIRST CALVING
- 7.) JUNIOR COW IN MILK HAVING HAD 2 OR 3 CALVES
- 8.) SENIOR COW – 4 OR MORE CALVES AND SPECIFY ON ENTRY FORM NUMBER OF CALVES.
- 9.) BEST DAIRY SHORTHORN FEMALE Sired BY AN SSUK BULL *(A SSUK bull is defined as any bull whose semen has been available through SSUK)*
- 10.) SCENIC PHOTO INCLUDING ONE OR MORE DAIRY SHORTHORN CATTLE *(this does not need to be professionally taken. £20 not given for entries into this class)*
